

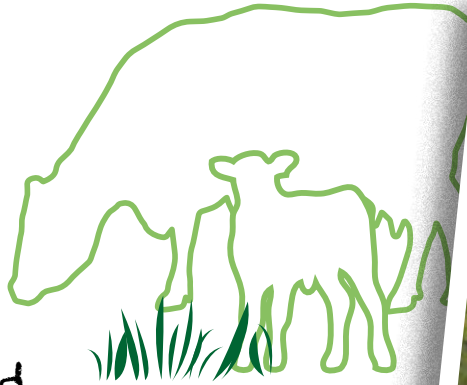
WHAT'S GRAZING IN MY FIELD?

Did you know?

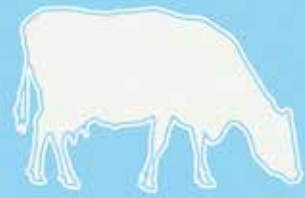
Cows mostly graze on fresh grass, growing in the same fields that store tonnes of carbon.
