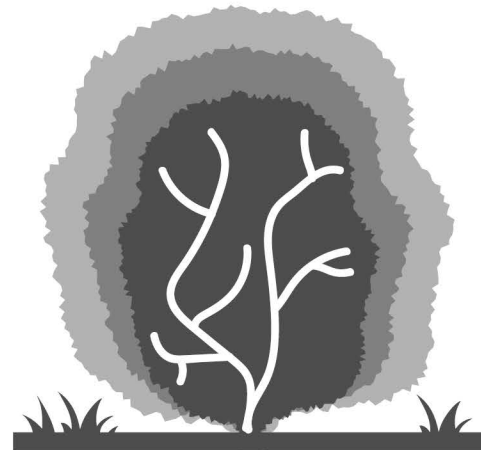


Increasing hedgerows can store half a million tonnes of CO₂ every year

That's the equivalent to taking more than 100,000 cars off the road

What does 0.5MtCO₂ mean on farm?

20%



Double the size of **20%** of your hedges (at least)



Extend your hedgerow length by at least **20%**



= **20%** increase in height along 450m of a short (1.5m) hedge

YOU CHOOSE

- Aim to allow hedgerow trees to grow every 40m
- Gap up
- Keep up maintenance
- Increase density
- Coppice or pollard for wood fuel
- Trim every two to three years
- Self-report hedge mapping
- Get storing now!
