# EDUCATION TRUST FUND OF THE WEST SUSSEX COUNTY BRANCH OF THE NFU

### History

A "Declaration of Trust" was made on the first day of August 1958 by the National Farmers' Union Trust Company Limited.

Whereas certain investments were transferred to and received by the Trustees as an "Education Fund" to be administered by the West Sussex County Branch of the National Farmers' Union for the benefit of persons resident in the administrative County of West Sussex engaged in or intending to engage in agriculture for the furtherance of their education or training in agricultural pursuits.

A Committee of Management was appointed to administer the Fund.

### Today

The Management Committee comprises six experienced farmers of West Sussex who are dedicated to the education and development of young people pursuing a future in agriculture and associated industries.

The Committee sits twice yearly, usually in May and November to consider applications from students who usually reside in West Sussex. Student grants are available to persons who intend to further their education in an agriculture college or university anywhere within the United Kingdom. The Committee has particularly interest in supporting students with a genuine determination to pursue a career in agriculture, commercial horticulture or associated industries, who are at risk of not being able to undertake or sustain their studies because of financial difficulties. In addition to student support, the Fund's management committee will consider applications for financial support from local West Sussex organisations actively involved in promoting agriculture and horticulture to young people.
