



KEEP YOUR BIRDS SAFE

It is important to practice good biosecurity if you keep poultry or captive birds. This is particularly important at times of notifiable disease such as Avian Influenza (bird flu). Keep your birds safe by following our tips.



CLEAN AND DISINFECT

regularly clean and disinfect hard areas your birds can access



RODENT CONTROL

is essential



FEED AND WATER

your birds in an area which wild birds can't access



MITES, WORMS ETC.

Keep an eye out and treat if necessary
