Dangerous goods are materials or items with hazardous properties which, if not properly handled, present a potential hazard to:

- human health and safety
- the environment • infrastructure

Look out for these symbols on any products you are using and check if your activities come within the scope of ADR:



Oxidising Substances



Harmful, Toxic or Irritating Substances



Explosive



Acute Toxic Substances



Corrosive Substances



Hazardous to the Environment



Flammable Substances



Serious Health Hazard Substances



Gas Under Pressure

Ask yourself:

1 Are the goods you wish to carry classified as dangerous?

3 Is the journey you are planning exempt from the regulations?

2 Is the vehicle you are using exempt from the regulations?

4 Does the type and quantity of goods you are carrying qualify for partial exemptions?

If you are not sure whether your goods are dangerous, contact the manufacturer.
