We have just taken the first 22 donated trucks and are looking to take the next 20 4x4's to Ukraine in late March 23

The aim of the initiative is to supply over 100 pick-up trucks to the front line by the middle of the year.

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP?

#### DONATE YOUR OLD PICK-UP OR 4WD

Speaking to the local communities impacted by the war, they urgently require supplies in many areas, from warm clothing, generators, ambulances and 4WD pickups and vehicles to deliver aid and supplies to the communities most impacted by the conflict.

Following previously successful delivery of reliable 4WDs to Eastern Ukraine we see a real opportunity for the UK Farming Community to provide direct support through donating their second hand pick-ups or similar.





All vehicles must have an MOT and be roadworthy so that they can be driven to West Ukraine

The Ukraine government has removed importation restrictions and duties to simplify the process and we have already fully tested the process for the safe delivery of these vehicles to Ukraine.

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP?

#### DONATE SUPPLIES OR YOUR TIME

Whilst the primary focus is on identifying 100 vehicles, ambulances and 4WDs for donation we shall take the opportunity to load these vehicles with other donated or purchased aid items from generators, spare tyres and parts to winter jackets etc.


We request those donating to drive their own vehicle or assist in providing someone to drive them overland to our operations in Lviv. We shall then deliver drivers to Rzeszow or Krakow in southern Poland for a flight back to the UK.

#### DONATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT

We know that not everyone has a spare vehicle or the time to drive one across Europe, however we shall still require further support in the form of funding to pay transportation or accommodation and flights back for some of the drivers.

This can either be donated directly to our funding account or by credit card through the just-giving web link on the next page. All funds will be managed by an independent committee.

#### **DETAILS:**

We sent the first 22 vehicles in early March and are looking to send the second convoy of vehicles over to Lviv at the end of March.

Those driving can either fly straight back from Southern Poland or can remain whilst the vehicles are handed over to the local team with a tour of Lviv and our operations.

A small dedicated team will be formed to manage this and provide governance oversight.

When hostilities cease, in the long-term recognition of donors, we shall hold an annual visit to the Lviv region for all who have helped in this initiative.

We shall have further deliveries to Ukraine in the next 4 months depending upon the levels of vehicles donated.
