What do I do next?

Make your dealership aware that you are an NFU member and are eligible for the discount. Dealership will complete relevant NFU member discount approval paperwork with you to email to the NFU for approval of the discount.

Terms and Conditions

1. The NFU member discount cannot be used with any Volkswagen Commercial Vehicles marketing offers available at the time.
2. This programme is available to NFU Farmer and Grower, NFU Partner, NFU Retired members only, which meet the following criteria:
 - i. Be an NFU Farmer and Grower member, Partner (provided they are linked to an F&G record), NFU Retired member.
 - ii. Have maintained 12 months of continuous membership at point of request, and
 - iii. Have made a minimum of 12 months subscription payment with a Direct Debit instruction set up for the current membership year if paying by Direct Debit or have made a minimum of 12 months subscription payment and in addition, have paid in full for the current membership year at the point of request, subject to NFU discretion, if a cash payer.
3. This programme is not available to any other NFU membership categories or any member that does not meet the eligibility criteria, as set out above.
4. Eligible members are allowed a maximum of 2 vehicle discounts per NFU membership year (membership year is 1st November – 31st October). This applies across all NFU vehicle partners and is not per manufacturer.
5. The NFU member must not sell, offer to sell, assign, part with possession of or otherwise deal with such commercial vehicle for a period of 12 months from the date of its delivery
6. The NFU member must provide the Volkswagen Van Centre with a valid UK driving licence. The name and address should match the member's details the NFU hold for them. A photocopy of the license will be taken by the supplying Volkswagen Commercial van Centre and kept for a minimum of 3 years for auditing purposes.
7. The Support is not available against any special edition or any tactical campaign models. The NFU member should check eligibility with the supplying Volkswagen Van Centre.
8. The NFU or Volkswagen Commercial Vehicles may change the terms and conditions, including the availability of the deal, and models included at any time and without notice.
9. Member discount is only available on an outright purchase agreement.
10. A discount is likely to be declined if:
 - i. The name and address on the approval form does not match details held by the NFU.
 - ii. The approval form is not signed by the member and completed in full before being submitted to the NFU.
