It is aimed at estate owners, land managers, farmers, land agents, rural consultants, conservationists, agronomists and chartered surveyors who wish to further develop an in-depth knowledge in the conservation arena. The course can be used towards the BASIS Diploma in Agronomy and it also delivers (30) CPD points to those on the BASIS Register.

The training, based at the Allerton Project, has a rich seam of evidence to support landscape conservation in a commercial farm context. It is backed by scientific research and practical application, implemented on our Leicestershire demonstration farm. Successfully delivered to over 300 candidates, with a pass rate of over 90%, the varied style of course content provides educational and essential business benefits into the future.

Key topics include: Farmland Wildlife & Habitats; Farming and the Wider Environment - for thriving plants and wildlife; Soil Management; Water & Environmental Protection - for cleaner air and water; Agricultural Specialism- Integrated Pest Management; Environmental Specialism – Habitat creation and management.
