

The award is open to all in the UK egg, poultrymeat and game sectors, who can show how training is benefiting their career and performance in their business.

The winner receives a £2,000 training grant from Zoetis, an engraved trophy and a ticket to the NFU conference. The runners up will also receive tickets to the NFU conference. The judging panel will shortlist three finalists to be interviewed. The finalists will be invited to the NFU National Poultry Board meeting on January 22 which will feature the presentation of the award. They will then have the opportunity to visit the Houses of Parliament and attend the award dinner at The Paternoster Chophouse. Hotel accommodation will be provided by Zoetis for all finalists and their partners.
